

# TEN TORS 2017 TEAM MANAGERS INFORMATION SHEET



### **INTRODUCTION**

- 1. Welcome to Okehampton Training Camp and Exercise WYVERN TOR 2017 (WT17). The administration for the exercise and camp area is being conducted by 6<sup>th</sup> Battalion The Rifles.
- 2. Our aim is to make your stay as enjoyable as possible but please bear in mind that there will be 3500 participants and helpers on the campsites, 1000 military personnel in the Camp and upwards of 5000 supporters visiting. Where possible we will try to accommodate all your needs but you do need to look after yourselves.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 3. The Defence Infrastructure Organisation and 6 RIFLES will endeavour to make the Camp and campsites as safe as reasonably practicable.
- 4. Team Managers are responsible for their participants, helpers and visitors, and must brief them within 30 minutes of arrival on a campsite. Supporters will receive basic safety, health and environmental information in the Ten Tors Brochure issued to all drivers on arrival in the car parks.
- 5. Everyone is responsible for their own health and safety, and for ensuring that their actions and omissions do not endanger others. Please treat the Camp and Dartmoor with care and have consideration for other users.

### SAFETY, HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

- 6. **Generators**. To enable emergency announcements to be heard, in consideration of others, and to reduce fuel hazards, generators are not permitted on the campsites.
- 7. **Fire Precautions.** Please help to reduce the risk of fire by not smoking in tents, by cooking carefully, by having appropriate fire extinguishers to hand, and by minimising the quantity of gas and fuel on the campsites All visitors who intend to use gas canisters in the camping areas must ensure that they observe a 6-metre safety distance from accommodation tents (this includes campervans located on the parking area). Keep the fire exit routes clear and make sure that everyone knows where they are.
- 8. **Action on the outbreak of fire.** Raise the alarm by shouting FIRE, FIRE, call 01837 657186 and 999 and muster on the Parade Square. Team Managers are to report missing persons to a Steward.
- 9. **Camp Site Layout**. Please keep your tents close together with walkways leading to the fire exit routes. Liaise with your neighbours to ensure walkways are joined up.
- 10. **Medical Assistance**. The British Red Cross First Aid post is to the south of the Parade Square.
- 11. **Waste.** This year, with the assistance of our contractor, we will once again be **green** with regard to waste. There will be general waste and recycling bins placed throughout the Camp and campsites, please use the correct bins.
- 12. **Litter.** Please pick up litter and dispose of it correctly. **Every little helps.**

- 13. **Dogs.** Dogs are not permitted on the campsites.
- 14. **Alcohol**. Team staff, especially minibus drivers who might be needed to support Contingency Plans, are encouraged not to drink alcohol.
- 15. **Safeguarding**. Team Managers are responsible for the conduct and safeguarding of any of their Establishment participants and minors, and for the behaviour of their team staff and supporters on the campsite.

### **VEHICLES**

- 16. You are to follow the one-way circuit and comply with the speed limit in Camp of **15 mph.** Drivers must obey the directions of Traffic Marshals and Stewards, who are identifiable by high viz waistcoats.
- 17. No vehicle is allowed on the campsites except essential vehicles with organiser's authority and Jubilee Challenge medical vehicles with Exeter UOTC permission.
- 18. Please ensure you park your vehicle in the public car park. Your vehicle will be towed away or you may receive a fixed penalty notice from the Police if it is parked illegally or causing an obstruction.
- 19. Vehicles may be unloaded on the Parade Square, on the road alongside campsites Y and Z, or from the areas within the car park close to the gates to the west of campsites A –F and JC.
- 20. **Camp Exit.** There will be **NO** vehicle exit from Okehampton Training Camp on Sat 6 May between 0600-0700 hrs. On Sun 7 May between 0900 and 1700 you will be directed onto the slip road onto the A30 westbound to reduce congestion in Okehampton Slip off at the next junction if you wish to drive in the Exeter direction.

### TRIBAR FACILITIES

21. There is a TRIBAR facility at Okehampton Camp, which is located in Building 112. Opening times for the TRIBAR during Ten Tors 2017 are as follows:
