

EXERCISE ARIES TOR 2015 INFORMATION SHEET



WELCOME

1. Welcome to Okehampton Training Camp and Exercise ARIES Tor 2015. The administration for the Exercise and camp area is being conducted on behalf of 1 Artillery Brigade and South West by 6 RIFLES.

ACCOMMODATION

2 Our aim is to make your stay as enjoyable as possible but please understand that we will have just short of 1000 personnel that will require accommodation at various times throughout A T 2015. Where possible we will try to accommodate all your needs. You will be expected to leave your room or bed space clean and tidy on your departure, as it may be required immediately as you leave.

HIRE VEHICLES

3. **Reception is in Building 130**. If you have arrived in a hired vehicle you are to ensure that it is parked in the hired vehicle white parking area. If it is a one way hire you are to hand the keys into reception. The keys will be enveloped up with registration number and hire firm on the outside. Hired vehicle firms will be directed to reception to collect keys before removing the vehicle from the hired vehicle parking area.

4. Hire firms dropping off hired vehicles for use after AT 2015 will be directed to park in the hired vehicle car park. Keys will be handed into reception where they will be enveloped with the name of the person the car is for and a tannoy announcement will be made.

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5. You are reminded of the need to observe the Health and Safety, and Environmental Protection Regulations. Please treat the camp and training area with care and have consideration for other users.

6. **Camp Exit.** There will be **NO** exit from Okehampton Training Camp on Sat 09 May 15 between 0600-0700hrs.

7. Drivers. You are to follow the one way circuit and comply with the speed limit in camp of 15 mph.

8. Parking. Please ensure you park your vehicle in the correct car park. Your vehicle will be towed away or you may receive a fixed penalty notice from the Police if it is parked illegally or causing an obstruction.

Aries Tors 2015

• Aries Tors is an annual self sufficient 2 day expedition run on Dartmoor by HQ 1Arty &SW Bde for teenagers mostly from the South West. The event is a challenging adventure that demands careful planning, imagination, endurance, skilful navigation and teamwork by all participants. The only competition is in finishing individually and as a team.

• 2,400 participants in four hundred teams of six tackle 35, 45 and 55 mile routes, depending on the age of the team. 19 Tors are manned to provide a variety of routes. The start is at 0700 on Saturday and must be competed by 1700 on Sunday. Following the successful introduction of the EMIT electronic check point system, this year sees the introduction of the ESEYE GPS tracker system which will provide real time locations of all 400 teams.

• Aries Tors is a climax of a structured and sustained training programme. The objectives are to instil an appreciation and respect for the landscape, wildlife and cultural heritage of Dartmoor, to promote a sense of adventure and fun, to contribute to the growth of self reliance and personal responsibility and to stimulate leadership qualities, to engender team spirit and to encourage a yearning for further challenges through new found confidence, motivation and success. In addition participants will develop fitness, navigation, first aid, self sufficiency, character and leadership.

• Up to 300 young people with a range of physical or mental needs take part in the Jubilee Challenge on the Saturday.

• There are four routes for the Jubilee Challenge, ranging from 7 ½ miles to 13 miles.

• Around 1,000 military personnel from all three services will be on duty during Aries Tors

• They will be supported by the Devon and Cornwall Police and up to 350 volunteers from the Dartmoor Rescue Group, St John Ambulance and Devon, 4x 4 Response and other volunteers.

• The organisers also value the support of the landowners, the National Park Authority and the Commoners Council for encouraging the participants to find out more about Dartmoor's special qualities, and how the land and farmers benefit us all.

• You too benefit, as the friction and uncertainty of Aries Tors provides realistic training for military assistance to civil emergencies such as flooding.

• Dartmoor Training Area is a vital training ground for the light and dismounted forces based in the south west as well as providing essential training for those from other parts of the country. The tors, mires and granite littered slopes combined with ever changing weather provide a demanding environment for tactical training up to battle group level.
